I. Law Making:

Introduction of Bills:

1. An Act to complete the formation of the Government within 90 days by the Republic of Liberia after every general and presidential election.
2. A Bill entitled: Non-Board fee payment Act, 2013.
3. An Act seeking Amendment to the Liberia Rubber Development Law of 2004.

II. Advocacy:

1. Taking Cocopa Plantation from a Foreign Management and replacing it with nationals; resolving the long-term salary arrears problem and severance payment at Cocopa.
2. The role he played in the merger of the Planning Ministry with Finance (separation PPCU from the newly merged entity and setting aside the Liberia Revenue Authority).For which has recently awarded by the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning.
3. His role in increasing the allotment of scholarship Fund for Nimba Students within the Social Development fund.
4. His role in seeking an increase in the allotment for other Faith- based institutions in Nimba; for instance, African Bible College University (ABCU), Yekepa; Liberia International Christian College (LICC), Ganta; Ganta Methodist Hospital.
5. His role on Arcelor Mittal reconditioning of CNC highway which connects Nimba with Bong.
6. Putting money in the budget for the Rubber Farmers & Brokers Union; Disabled (Mainly the blind) and for the rehabilitation of Kpain Road.
7. Calling for the scrutiny of the rubber sector and fighting Firestone monopoly in the sector.
8. Lobbying with Jonah Capital and Land, Mines and Energy Ministry to construct an annex to Kpoapa School and rehabilitate Gbahn School.
